Notes

1. During the semester, summer session, and winter break, in addition to the accommodation fee and security deposit, residents are required to pay the following fees:
 - (1) Dormitory No. 1: Room electricity, hot water, and gas fees.
 - (2) Dormitory No. 7: Room electricity, heat pump electricity, heat pump water, and heat pump maintenance fees.
 - (3) Dormitory No. 2: Room electricity, heat pump electricity, heat pump water, heat pump maintenance, and gas fees.
2. Water, electricity, and gas fees for all dormitories are calculated based on the unit rates indicated in official utility bills.
3. For Dormitories No. 7 and No. 2, heat pump electricity and water fees are shared equally among residents based on the total consumption of the heat pump system.
The heat pump maintenance fee is calculated at a rate of NT\$50 per person per month.
4. The summer accommodation fee for the In-Service Graduate Summer Master's Program and for summer camps includes electricity, hot water, gas, heat pump electricity, heat pump water, and heat pump maintenance fees.
5. Summer camp accommodation fees are calculated on a weekly basis. Any stays of less than one week shall be charged as a full week.
6. The fee standards in this table shall take effect from Academic Year 115 (2026); accommodation fees are calculated based on the actual number of weeks the dormitories are open.
7. The accommodation fees are calculated by multiplying the number of weeks, and the final amount will be rounded up to the nearest whole number.
8. Starting from Academic Year 118 (2029), accommodation fees will be adjusted every three years based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
